

Two Drop Peyote Bracelet

Things to know about completing this bracelet:

- This bracelet is done using the Two drop method of Peyote stitch. It is worked the same as regular Peyote stitch, you just pick up two beads and go through two beads for each stitch.
- It is done in odd count peyote.
- Start in the middle (where the break in the graph occurs) and work about half the bracelet and complete the end with the button. Then finish the other end, making it the desired length by repeating the pattern before tapering to the point and adding the loop.
- The pictured bracelet is shown using the Toho 1.5 mm cube beads, but will also work up nicely with cylinder beads or round beads of any size.
